Colour: Deep, ruby-purple colour, lighter on the rim.

Bouquet: The bouquet is full and harmonious; aromas of red fruit interweave subtle floral, minty herbs enriched by spice. Full-bodied, aromas of raspberries, red plums intermix cashews, unfolding black pepper and dark herbs.

Palate: The palate has vibrancy, and a lightness contributes by lively acidity; fine-grained ripe tannin adds weight and texture. This Shiraz has the classic elements complemented by a vibrant acid line.

Food: Match with kangaroo stew and Mediterranean fare over the next 8 years.
