Since 1971 the Hickinbotham family have been renowned, quality, cost efficient grape growers for some of the industry's leading winemakers including the world-famous Penfold's Grange Hermitage, Eileen Hardy and Clarendon Hills.

In 2004, the 3 Rings label was established to showcase Shiraz and the Barossa Valley and since then, it has received an impressive medal tally abroad including;

In 2017, David, his wife Dena and their son Alan Robb Hickinbotham, purchased the iconic Barossa Valley Vineyard 'Biscay Road' where the family had been purchasing fruit from for the 3 Rings Brand since 2009. Alan manages this vineyard.

The Barossa is to Australia, what the Napa is to California and Bordeaux and Burgundy is to France. We have over 120 acres of vineyards for our Estate Grown, Estate Made Barossa Wine.


